JANUARY 2026 MONTHLY FEE INCREASE FOR GRADES

1-6

Our board of directors has reviewed our financial situation and due to rising costs of our expenses, they have decided that it is necessary to increase the monthly fees for the Grade 1-6 children to ensure the long term sustainability of the centre.

The new monthly fees will come into effect on January 1, 2026 and will be as follows:

Grades 1-6

Full Time = \$680/ child per month Part Time = \$630/ child per month

Daily Drop in Fees
Regular School Day = \$45/ child per day
Full Day Child Care = \$60/ child per day

(Note: The Kindergarten monthly fees remain unchanged due to the Affordability Grant Agreement)

REMINDER ABOUT SPECIAL TREATS

Please refrain from bring in any treats into the center that are not prepackaged with listed ingredients due to children on-site with life threatening allergies

REMINDERS

If your child will be absent, please ensure you notify the centre in advance. We will expect all children to be attending each day unless notified otherwise.

When notifying the centre of your child being sick, please state what your child's symptoms are to the staff, as per Alberta Health Services standard we need to keep a record.

- o Children who are recovering from...
- o fever will be required to stay home for 24 hours.
- o vomiting and diarrhea will be required to stay home for 48 hours as per AHS requirements.

Please do not let anyone into the centre. It is the responsibility of the RSOSC staff to answer the door to ensure we are aware of all people entering the building.

Please ensure to send your child with appropriate gear for the weather each day. Each child should arrive to the centre every day with clothing appropriate for playing outside everyday.

**As per the Parent Handbook, "a fee of \$2.00 a minute per child will be charged for each minute after 6:00 p.m. that a child remains at the Centre."
